JACKSON SOUTHWEST LITTLE LEAGUE

Age Groups

-Tee Ball (Co-Ed): 4 and 5 year olds, unless 5 year old is playing Coach Pitch at guardians discretion.

-Coach Pitch (Co-Ed): 6 and 7 year olds.

-Intermediate Minors Baseball: 7 and 8 year olds unless an 8 year old is selected to play minors, and 6 year olds with signed agreement stating they wish to have their 6 year old child play in intermediate minors. Teams will be re-drafted every year. All 7 and 8 year olds need to attend evaluations.

-Minors Softball: All 8, 9 and 10 year olds unless a 10 year old is selected up to play Majors. 8 year olds may be selected to a minors team. The number of 8 year olds selected will be limited to the number required to fill out minor teams to the target roster AND guardian must sign an agreement stating they wish to have their 8 year old child play in minors if selected. Teams will be re-drafted every year. All 8, 9, and 10 year olds need to attend evaluations.

-Minors Baseball: All 9 and 10 year olds unless a 10 year old is selected up to play Majors. 8 year olds may be selected to a minors team. The number of 8 year olds selected will be limited to the number required to fill out minor teams to the target roster AND guardian must sign an agreement stating they wish to have their 8 year old child play in minors if selected. Teams will be re-drafted every year. All 8, 9, and 10 year olds need to attend evaluations.

-Majors Softball and Baseball: All 11 and 12 year olds, and 10 year olds selected through evaluations. The number of 10 year olds selected will be limited to the number required to fill out major teams to the target roster. Players drafted to Majors teams in previous years will remain on the same team. All other 10, 11, and 12 year olds need to attend evaluations.

-Exceptions: Players may be asked to play up or down a league if there are concerns for player safety. Guardians will be consulted and a decision will be made by the JSWLL board in conjunction with the guardian that will be in the best interest of the player(s).

Difference Between the Divisions

-Tee-Ball: All players hit off a tee, all players play in field, 3 innings or 1 hour maximum. No umpires.

-Coach Pitch: All players hit, all players play in field, 3 innings or 1 hour maximum. No umpires.

-Intermediate Minors: Kid pitch first three innings, 30 pitch maximum per kid per game. Walks and strikeouts are valid. Machine Pitch final 2 innings. 10 players in the field, all players bat. Games are 5 innings or 1.5 hour maximum. One umpire.

-Minors: All kid pitch, 10 players in field, all players bat, 6 Innings. Two umpires.

-Majors: Full Little League baseball- 9 players in field, minimum one at bat & two defensive innings per player per game. Two umpires.
